Bylaw Update Process

- 1. Community learning with Select Board (SB) and Planning Commission (PC);
- 2. PC and SB updates Municipal Plan or Local Hazard Mitigation Plan if needed;
- 3. PC reviews the model bylaw and edits as needed;
- 4. Request review with the NFIP checklist by your Regional VT DEC Floodplain Manager
- 5. PC hearing;
- 6. Adopt and report language to SB;
- 7. SB hearing and adoption.
